Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 3) 2024

I, Hugh Crosby Heggie, Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 35 of the *Interpretation Act 1978* and for the *Financial Management Act 1995* and the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993*, make the following order.

1 Commencement and application

- (1) This order commences on 10 September 2024.
- (2) This order has effect subject to any Act.

2 Revocation of previous order

The order entitled "Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 2) 2024" dated 27 March 2024 and notified in *Gazette* No. S24 of 27 March 2024, is revoked.

3 Nomination of Agencies for *Financial Management Act 1995* and *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993*

- (1) A department or other authority or body listed in Schedule 1, Part 1, is nominated as an Agency for:
 - (a) the *Financial Management Act 1995*; and
 - (b) the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993*.
- (2) A department or other authority or body listed in Schedule 1, Part 2, is nominated as an Agency for the *Financial Management Act 1995*.
- (3) A department or other authority or body listed in Schedule 1, Part 3, is nominated as an Agency for the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 1993*.

4 Allocation of Acts, areas or activities of government, government authorities or entities and Agencies to Ministers

The Minister holding a Ministerial office mentioned in Schedule 2 is allocated:

- (a) administration of each Act listed in Schedule 2, column 1 for the Ministerial office; and
- (b) responsibility for each area or activity of government and government authority or government entity listed in Schedule 2, column 2 for the Ministerial office; and
- (c) administration of each Agency specified in Schedule 2 for the Ministerial office to the extent that administration relates to the Acts, areas or activities of government and government authorities or entities mentioned in paragraphs (a) and (b).

5 Allocation of Acts, areas or activities of government and government authorities or entities to Agencies

An Agency listed in Schedule 2 is allocated:

- (a) administration of each Act listed in Schedule 2, column 1, for the Agency; and
- (b) responsibility for each area or activity of government and government authority or government entity listed in Schedule 2, column 2, for the Agency.
