Regulations under the Marine Act 1981

Part I Introductory

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Marine (Sheltered Waters)* Regulations 1986.

2 Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears:

Code means the Uniform Code and includes appendices thereto.

partially smooth waters means water areas where the wave height, under normal circumstances, does not exceed 1.5 m from trough to crest.

section, **clause** and **note** mean section, clause, and note of the Code

sheltered waters areas means partially smooth waters and smooth waters.

smooth waters means water areas where the wave height, under normal conditions, does not exceed 0.5 m from trough to crest.

Part II Application of Code

3 Application of part of section 1

(1) Clause 5.2 of section 1 is adopted as modified in the manner provided by subregulation (2).

- (2) There shall be in addition to the specification of sheltered water areas contained in Appendix B NT to note 2 of clause 5.2 of section 1:
 - (a) with respect to smooth waters, those areas set out in Column 1 of Schedule 1 opposite those limits set out in Column 2; and
 - (b) with respect to partially smooth waters, those areas set out in Column 1 of Schedule 2 opposite those limits set out in Column 2.

Bathurst Island – Gullala Creek	All waters enclosed by a line from a position latitude 11° 30.85' south longitude 130° 11.7' east to a position latitude 11° 30.50' south longitude 130° 11.7' east.
Bathurst Island – Perarkery Creek	All waters enclosed by a line from a position latitude 11° 42.25' south longitude 130° 08.5' east to a position latitude 11° 42.45' south longitude 130° 08.6' east.
Dalywoi Bay	All waters enclosed by a line from a point in latitude 12° 20.85' south longitude 136° 55.3' east in a direction 000° (T) to a point in latitude 12° 20.65' south longitude 136° 55.3' east.

Schedule 2

Column 1	Column 2
Bathurst Island – Port Hurd	All waters enclosed by a line from a position latitude 11° 38.70' south longitude 130° 11.40' east to a position latitude 11° 39.15' south longitude 130° 11.7' east.
Bynoe Harbour	All waters enclosed by a line in a direction 280° (T) from East Point in position latitude 12° 34.13' south longitude 130° 33.88' east to West Point in position latitude 12° 33.60' south longitude 130° 30.95' east and by a line in a direction 223° (T) from Hut Point in position latitude 12°35.08' south longitude 130° 29.15' east to a position in latitude 12° 38.18' south longitude 130° 26.22' east.
Dalywoi Bay	All waters enclosed by a line from Needle Point latitude 12° 19.5' south longitude 136° 56.4' east in a direction 131° (T) to a point in latitude 12° 20.65' south longitude 136° 57.7' east to the limits of the declared smooth water area.
Gove Harbour	All waters enclosed by a line from Wargarpunda Point latitude 12° 11' south longitude 136° 41' east in a direction 268½° (T), to a point in latitude 12° 11.1' south longitude 136° 35.7' east.
Port Bradshaw	All waters enclosed by a line from Gwapillina Point latitude 12° 33.5' south longitude 136° 46.2' east in a direction 270° (T) to a point in latitude 12° 33.5' south longitude 136° 45.1' east.

Port Essington

All waters enclosed by a line from Smith Point latitude 11° 07.22' south longitude 132° 08.32' east to Gunner Quoin latitude 11° 11.00' south longitude 132° 01.80' east.

Vanderlin Island

All waters enclosed by lines commencing at a point at latitude 15° 52.5' south longitude 137° east, from there to a point at latitude 15° 52' south longitude 137° 04' east, from there to a point at latitude 15° 48' south longitude 137° 7' east, from there to a point at latitude 15° 38' south longitude 137° 05.5' east, from there to a point at latitude 15° 30' south longitude 137° 53.5' east, from there to a point at latitude 15° 30' south longitude 137° 36.5' east, and from there to the point of commencement.
