Regulations under the *Registration Act 1927*

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Registration Regulations 2009*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of section 109 of the *Unit Title Schemes Act 2009*.

3 Fees, charges and levies

Schedule 1 prescribes the fees, charges and levies payable under the Acts mentioned in it.

4 Repeals

The Regulations specified in Schedule 2 are repealed.
