# Regulations under the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act

#### 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Regulations*.

## 2 Prescribed law enforcement agencies

For the purposes of paragraph (n) of the definition of *law enforcement agency* in section 3 of the Act:

- (a) the police force of New Zealand; and
- (b) the International Police Organisation, known as INTERPOL, are prescribed bodies.

# 3 Exemption in relation to certain decisions of Private Security Licensing Authority

Section 13 of the Act does not apply in relation to the making of a decision by the Private Security Licensing Authority under the *Private Security Act* whether to grant, renew, suspend or cancel a licence.
