EVIDENCE REGULATIONS

Regulations under the *Evidence Act*

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Evidence Regulations*.

2 Prescribed fee for public documents

For the purposes of section 29(7) of the Act the prescribed fee is \$10 plus \$1.50 per page of the document.

3 Prescribed qualifications for reporting scientist

For the definition ***reporting scientist*** in section 24 of the Act, each of the following is a prescribed qualification:

- (a) a degree of Bachelor of Molecular Biology awarded by a university in Australia or New Zealand;
- (b) a degree equivalent to a degree mentioned in paragraph (a);
- (c) another science degree that, combined with at least 6 months experience as a forensic scientist at a laboratory, is equivalent to a degree mentioned in paragraph (a) or (b).
