CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY LONG SERVICE LEAVE AND BENEFITS REGULATIONS

Regulations under the Construction Industry Long Service Leave and Benefits Act

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Construction Industry Long Service Leave and Benefits Regulations*.

2 Imposition of levy

Section 32(2)(b) of the Act has effect, in so far as it relates to construction work for a Class 10 building under the Building Code of Australia, so that the levy is imposed on so much of construction work as is not for a Class 10(a) building.

3 Amount of levy

For section 33(1) of the Act, the percentage of 0.4% is prescribed.

4 Payment by instalments

For section 44(1)(a) of the Act, the amount of \$10 000 is prescribed.

5 Interest payments

For section 45(1) of the Act, the rate is 2 percentage points above the Reserve Bank of Australia daily cash rate.

6 Review by Court

For section 85(2)(b) of the Act, the specified period is 60 days after the application under section 84 of the Act is made.

7 Transitional matters for Construction Industry Long Service Leave and Benefits Amendment Regulations 2009

- (1) If construction work has started before the commencement of regulation 4 of the Construction Industry Long Service Leave and Benefits Amendment Regulations 2009 (the amending regulations), the levy rate in force immediately before the commencement of that regulation applies to all that construction work (including work that takes place after that commencement).
- (2) The levy rate as amended by regulation 4 of the amending regulations applies to construction work that starts after the commencement of that regulation (including work that takes place after the commencement of regulation 5 of the amending regulations).
- (3) The levy rate as amended by regulation 5 of the amending regulations applies to construction work that starts after the commencement of that regulation.
