Regulations under the Mutual Recognition (Northern Territory) Act

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Mutual Recognition* (Temporary Exemption for Beverage Containers) Regulations.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Part 2 of the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act.*

3 Temporary exemption for certain beverage containers

For section 15 of the Commonwealth Act, the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act* is, to the extent it relates to regulated containers, a law to which that section applies.

4 Expiry

These Regulations expire 12 months after they commence.
