## TRANS-TASMAN MUTUAL RECOGNITION (TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FOR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS) REGULATIONS

### Regulations under the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act*

#### 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Temporary Exemption for Beverage Containers) Regulations*.

#### 2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the commencement of Part 2 of the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act*.

#### 3 Temporary exemption for certain beverage containers

For section 46 of the Commonwealth Act, the *Environment Protection (Beverage Containers and Plastic Bags) Act* is, to the extent it relates to regulated containers, exempt from the operation of the Commonwealth Act.

#### 4 Expiry

These Regulations expire 12 months after they commence.
