## LOCAL COURT REGULATIONS

# Regulations under the Local Court Act

# 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Local Court Regulations*.

## 2 Fees

Subject to regulations 4 and 5, the fee payable for a procedure or matter specified in the Schedule is the fee specified in the Schedule opposite the procedure or matter.

# 3 Time for payment of fees

- (1) A fee specified in item 1, 2, 3 or 4 of the Schedule is payable to the Court:
  - (a) in the case of a fee specified in item 1 or 2 at the time of filing; or
  - (b) in the case of a fee specified in item 3 or 4 on demand by the Court.
- (2) A fee specified in item 5 or 6 is payable to the bailiff:
  - (a) in the case of a fee specified in item 5 on demand by the bailiff after service; or
  - (b) in the case of a fee specified in item 6 on execution of the warrant.

# 4 Exemption from payment of fee

(1) Subject to subregulation (3), a person acting in a proceeding for or by the authority of the Territory is, in relation to that proceeding, exempt from payment of the fees specified in item 1 or 2 of the Schedule.

- (2) A person exempt from payment of a fee under subregulation (1) is entitled to recover, as part of a judgment debt as if it were a cost incurred, an amount equal to the fee that would, but for that subregulation, have been payable.
- (3) On recovery of the fee, the person must pay an amount equal to the fee to the Court.

# 5 Waiver of fee in case of hardship

If, in a particular case, the Registrar is of the opinion that the payment of a fee specified in item 1, 2, 3 or 4 of the Schedule would cause financial hardship to the plaintiff, applicant or party who must pay the fee, the Registrar may waive payment of the whole or a part of the fee.
