Regulations under the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act*

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Temporary Exemptions) Regulations*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 January 1999.

3 Temporary exemptions relating to certain electrical equipment

For the purposes of section 46 of the Commonwealth Act, the *Electricity By-Laws* are declared to be exempt from the operation of the Commonwealth Act to the extent that they deal with articles of electrical equipment.

4 Expiry

These Regulations expire 12 months after the day on which they commence.
