CRIMINAL RECORDS (SPENT CONVICTIONS) REGULATIONS

Regulations under the Criminal Records (Spent Convictions) Act

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Records* (Spent Convictions) Regulations.

2 Prescribed law enforcement agencies

For paragraph (n) of the definition *law enforcement agency* in section 3(1) of the Act, the following bodies are prescribed:

- (a) the police force of New Zealand;
- (b) the International Police Organisation, known as INTERPOL;
- (c) the United Kingdom Criminal Records Bureau.

2A Exemption for disclosure of information to CrimTrac

(1) Section 12 of the Act does not apply in relation to disclosure by the Northern Territory Police Force of a spent record or information relating to a spent record to CrimTrac for incorporation into the police information sharing system known as the National Police Reference System.

Note for subregulation (1)

This regulation is made under section 19(3) of the Act.

(2) In this regulation:

CrimTrac means the CrimTrac Agency established under section 65 of the *Public Service Act 1999* (Cth).

3 Exemption in relation to certain decisions of Private Security Licensing Authority

Section 13 of the Act does not apply in relation to the making of a decision by the Northern Territory Licensing Commission under the *Private Security Act* whether to grant, renew, suspend or cancel a license.

Note for regulation 3

This regulation is made under section 19(3) of the Act.
