FOOD STANDARDS REGULATIONS

Regulations under the *Food Act*

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Food Standards Regulations*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Food Act 1986*.

3 Interpretation

In these regulations, ***Food Standards Code*** means the food standards and the matters relating to them determined by the National Health and Medical Research Council and approved by the National Food Standards Council as published in Commonwealth *Gazette* No. P27 of 27 August 1987 and as published in the Commonwealth *Gazette* from time to time.

4 Code adopted as law of Territory

- (1) The Food Standards Code is hereby adopted as a law of the Territory, and shall have effect as if its provisions were regulations incorporated in these Regulations.
- (2) If there is conflict between a provision of the Food Standards Code and of the *Food (Interim Provisions) Regulations* or, as the case may be, the *Weights and Measures (Date-Marking of Pre-Packaged Foods) Regulations* in respect of the application of any of those provisions to food, the provision of the Food Standards Code shall prevail.
