ALCOHOL HARM REDUCTION REGULATIONS

Regulations under the Alcohol Harm Reduction Act

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Alcohol Harm Reduction Regulations*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day on which they are notified in the *Gazette*.

3 Person who may apply to BDR Registrar for making of BDO

- (1) For section 18(1)(g) of the Act, the following persons are prescribed:
 - (a) the Commissioner of Correctional Services;
 - (b) a paramedic employed or engaged by an ambulance service;
 - (c) a social worker, being a person eligible for full membership of the Australian Association of Social Workers;
 - (d) a person at a sobering up shelter who manages the shelter.
- (2) In this regulation:

sobering up shelter means a facility that provides supervised, non-custodial accommodation for adults affected by alcohol.
