## NORTHERN TERRITORY CIVIL AND ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL REGULATIONS 2014

### Regulations under the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2014*

#### **1 Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Northern Territory Civil and Administrative Tribunal Regulations 2014*.

#### **2 Fees**

- (1) The fee payable in relation to a matter specified in the Schedule is the fee specified opposite the matter.
- (2) A fee specified in item 2 of the Schedule is payable by the applicant in a proceeding.

#### **3 Time for payment of fees**

A fee, other than a fee specified in item 1 of the Schedule, is payable to the Tribunal on demand by the Tribunal.

*Note for regulation 3*

*A fee specified in item 1 of the Schedule must accompany the application to which it relates – see section 94(2) of the Act.*

#### **4 Territory exempt from payment of fees**

- (1) Despite regulation 2, a person acting in a proceeding for or by the authority of the Territory is, for that proceeding, exempt from payment of fees.
- (2) However, the Tribunal may, under a costs order, require that an amount equal to any fees that would, but for subregulation (1), have been payable, be paid to the person and on receipt of that amount the person must pay the amount to the Tribunal.

**5 Registrar may waive fees**

If, in a particular case, the Registrar considers that the payment of a fee would cause financial hardship to the person who must pay the fee, the Registrar may waive payment of the whole or part of the fee.

**6 Decisions not reviewable**

For section 140(1A) of the Act, a decision of the Tribunal under section 196 or 197 of the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law cannot be reviewed by the Tribunal.
