#### **UTILITIES COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

## Regulations under the Utilities Commission Act

#### 1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Utilities Commission Regulations*.

#### 2 Authorisation to make code

- (1) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make a code relating to ring fencing in a regulated industry.
- (2) In subregulation (1):

**ring fencing** means the separate operation of related or associated businesses of a licensed entity in a regulated industry.

#### 3 Authorisation to make rules and determinations

- (1) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make rules relating to the provision of ancillary services in the electricity supply industry.
- (2) The Utilities Commission is authorised to make determinations relating to the prices for providing ancillary services in the electricity supply industry.
- (3) In this regulation:

## ancillary services include:

- (a) reserve capacity;
- (b) frequency support;
- (c) load following services; and
- (d) services necessary for the efficient and reliable operation of a power system.
