An Act to revise and correct the law of the Territory in minor respects

[Assented to 31 August 2011] [Second reading 2 December 2010]

#### The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act 2011.

#### 2 Commencement
