# AN ACT

### to amend legislation consequent on the enactment of the Australian Crime Commission (Northern Territory) Act 2005

[Assented to 17 March 2005] [Second reading 1 December 2004]

## The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Australian Crime Commission (Consequential Amendments) Act 2005.

#### 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which the Australian Crime Commission (Northern Territory) Act 2005 commences.

#### 3. Amendments of laws

The laws specified in the Schedule are amended as set out in the Schedule.

## 4. Amendment by subordinate legislation authorised

Subordinate legislation amended by this Act may be amended or repealed by subordinate legislation as if the amendments had been made by subordinate legislation.
