Act No. 54 of 2004

AN ACT

to revise and correct the law of the Territory in minor respects

[Assented to 15 September 2004] [Second reading 16 June 2004]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act (No. 2) 2004.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the date fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. Amendment of Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act

The heading to Part III of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act is repealed.

4. Amendment of Legal Practitioners Act

Section 130AE of the Legal Practitioners Act is amended by omitting subsection (4).

5. Amendment of *Prostitution Regulation Act*

Section 54 of the *Prostitution Regulation Act* is repealed and the following substituted:

"(1) The Administrator may make regulations, not inconsistent with this Act, prescribing matters -

- (a) required or permitted by this Act to be prescribed; or
- (b) necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Act.
- "(2) The Regulations may provide for –
- (a) the payment of a prescribed amount instead of a penalty that may otherwise be imposed for an offence against this Act; and
- (b) the service of a notice relating to payment of the prescribed amount on a person alleged to have committed the offence and the particulars to be included in the notice.".

6. Amendments of Northern Territory Rail Safety Regulations

The Northern Territory Rail Safety Regulations are amended --

- (a) by omitting regulation 24(2)(b) and substituting the following:
 - "(b) the person has complied with any conditions on which the accredited person's permission is given."; and
- (b) by omitting regulation 28(2)(b) and (c) and substituting the following:
 - "(b) either of the following applies:
 - (i) subregulations (2A), (3) and (4) have been complied with;
 - (ii) the person driving the vehicle is
 - (A) a railway employee or inspector carrying out his or her duties;
 - (B) the owner or occupier of land adjoining or adjacent to a railway, an employee or agent of the owner or occupier or any other person acting to protect life or property, control or extinguish a fire or otherwise deal with an emergency; or

(C) a person who is permitted by the relevant accredited person to cross the level crossing without complying with subregulations (2A), (3) and (4).".

7. Revision of other Acts

The Acts specified in Schedule 1 are amended as set out in that Schedule.

8. Revision of other subordinate legislation

The subordinate legislation specified in Schedule 2 is amended as set out in that Schedule.

9. Amendment by subordinate legislation authorised

Subordinate legislation amended by this Act may be amended or repealed by subordinate legislation as if the amendments had been made by subordinate legislation.
