AN ACT

to repeal the Auctioneers Act

[Assented to 13 September 2002] [Second reading 19 June 2002]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Auctioneers Act Repeal Act 2002.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the date fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. Repeal

The Acts specified in the Schedule are repealed.

4. Transitional matter

- (1) In this section –
- "repealed Act" means the *Auctioneers Act* as in force immediately before the commencement of this Act.
- (2) A person who immediately before the commencement of this Act held an auctioneer's licence under the repealed Act is, during the period of 12 months after the commencement of a code of practice applicable to

auctioneers prescribed under section 239 of the *Consumer Affairs and Fair Trading Act*, taken to comply with any requirements of that code relating to the eligibility of a person to be an auctioneer.
