# NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

## AN ACT

to amend various Acts on the passing of the  
*Sentencing Act 1995*

[Assented to 29 April 1996]

**B**E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

### 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Sentencing (Consequential Amendments) Act 1996*.

### 2. COMMENCEMENT

(1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Sentencing Act 1995*.

(2) Section 7 shall come into operation on the date the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

### 3. AMENDMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH ACT

The *Mental Health Act* is amended by inserting after section 21 in Part IV the following:

#### "21A. APPLICATION

"Where, after the commencement of the *Sentencing Act*, a court finds a person guilty of an offence and the court is of the opinion that the person may be mentally ill, the court shall not make an order under this Part in respect of the person but shall deal with the person under Part 4 of the *Sentencing Act*."

## *Sentencing (Consequential Amendments)*

### 4. AMENDMENT OF *TRAFFIC ACT*

(1) Section 20(6) of the *Traffic Act* is amended by omitting "convicted" and "conviction" and substituting "found guilty" and "finding of guilt", respectively.

(2) Section 20A(15) of the *Traffic Act* is amended -

(a) by omitting "convicted" and substituting "found guilty"; and

(b) by omitting "*Criminal Law (Conditional Release of Offenders) Act*" and substituting "*Criminal Law (Conditional Release of Offenders) Act* or section 10 or 11 of the *Sentencing Act*".

(3) Section 39(1) of the *Traffic Act* is amended -

(a) by omitting all words before paragraph (c) and substituting the following:

"(1) Where -

(a) a person is found guilty of an offence against a section specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1, the person's licence is, by force of the conviction or finding of the court, cancelled and the person is disqualified from holding a licence -";

(b) by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following:

"(3) A court by which a person is found guilty shall, at the time of making the finding, specifically find that the offence to which the finding of guilt relates is the first, second or subsequent relevant offence for the purposes of subsection (1)(c) or (d)."; and

(c) by omitting from subsection (4) "conviction or finding" and substituting "being found guilty".

(4) Section 49 of the *Traffic Act* is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(3) In this section, a reference to an offence being committed against a provision includes a finding of guilt in relation to the offence.".

### 5. AMENDMENT OF *WORK HEALTH ACT*

Section 3 of the *Work Health Act* is amended by inserting after subsection (3) the following:

"(4) A natural person performing work under a community service order (made under or continued in force by the *Sentencing Act*) shall be deemed to be a worker in the employ of the Territory during the time the person is performing work under the order and, where the person is

employed by another person as a P.A.Y.E. taxpayer during normal working hours and was so employed during those hours immediately preceding the time he performed work under the order, his normal weekly earnings in that employment shall be deemed, for the purpose of this Act, to be his normal weekly earnings when performing work under the order."

#### 6. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The provisions of the Acts specified in the Schedule are amended as provided for in the Schedule.

#### 7. TRANSITIONAL

(1) Subject to subsection (2), the Administrator may make regulations under this Act amending this Act or any other Act where the amendments are necessary or convenient for ensuring the effective operation of the *Sentencing Act* and the amendments are of a transitional or consequential nature.

(2) Subsection (1) shall cease to have effect 12 months after the commencement of the *Sentencing Act*.

(3) Regulations made under subsection (1) shall have effect as if they were an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly.
