NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

to amend the Northern Territory Products Symbol Act

[Assented to 15 November 1995]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Northern Territory Products Symbol Amendment Act 1995.

2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Northern Territory Products Symbol Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. INTERPRETATION

Section 3(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of "symbol" the words "in Schedule 1" and substituting "in the Regulations".

4. OFFENCES

Section 6 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "knowing that that product" and substituting "if the product".

5. PERSON OBSTRUCTING OPERATION OF ACT

Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsections (1) and (2) "wilfully".

6. NEW SECTION

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 15 the following:

"16. REGULATIONS

- "(1) The Administrator may make regulations, not inconsistent with this Act, prescribing all matters -
 - (a) required or permitted by this Act to be prescribed; or
 - (b) necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Act.
- "(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the Regulations may provide for -
 - (a) the form and design of the symbol and other matters relating to the symbol;
 - (b) the payment of a prescribed amount in lieu of a penalty which may otherwise be imposed for an offence against this Act; and
 - (c) the service of notices on persons alleged to have infringed this Act and particulars to be included in such notices.".

7. REPEAL

Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is repealed.
