## The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

This Act may be cited as the Disasters Amendment Act 2007.

- (2) If a tropical cyclone watch or warning is issued for a part of the Territory by the Bureau of Meteorology, sections 37(1)(e)(iii) and 38 apply in relation to that part of the Territory while the watch or warning is current as if the watch or warning were a declaration of a state of emergency.
- (3) In this section:

**Bureau of Meteorology** means the Commonwealth Bureau of Meteorology established by the *Meteorology Act 1955* (Cth).
