## AN ACT

to amend the Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education Act

## The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

### 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Batchelor Institute of Indigenous Tertiary Education Amendment Act 2005*.

## 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the date fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

### **17A.** Duties of members

A member of the Council, when exercising a power or performing a function of the office -

- (a) must act always in the best interests of the Institute as a whole (with this obligation to be observed in priority to any duty the member may owe to those who elected or nominated him or her); and
- (b) must act in good faith, honestly and for a proper purpose; and
- (c) must exercise appropriate care and diligence; and
- (d) must not use his or her office to improperly gain an advantage (either for the member or another person); and
- (e) must disclose and avoid conflicts of interest.

# 7. Amendment of section 18 (Vacation or termination of office of member)

(2) Subject to subsection (3), the Council may terminate a member's appointment if it is satisfied that the member has not carried out his or her duties under section 17A.

(3) The Council can only exercise its power under subsection (2) if at least two-thirds of the members of the Council agree at a meeting that the member has not carried out his or her duties under section 17A.
