An Act to amend the Criminal Property Forfeiture Act

[Assented to 13 November 2014] [Second reading 27 August 2014]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Property Forfeiture Amendment Act 2014.*

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day fixed by the Administrator by *Gazette* notice.

Part 14 Transitional matters for Criminal Property Forfeiture Amendment Act 2014

167 Application of Criminal Property Forfeiture Amendment Act 2014

- (1) This Act, as amended by the *Criminal Property Forfeiture Amendment Act 2014*, applies only in relation to proceedings under this Act that are commenced after the commencement of this section (the *commencement*).
- (2) This Act, as in force before the commencement, continues to apply in relation to proceedings that were commenced before the commencement.

9 Expiry of Act

This Act expires on the day after it commences.
