Act No. 1 of 2019

An Act to amend the *Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1990*, the *Law Officers Act 1978*, the *Local Court Act 2015* and the *Supreme Court Act 1979*

[Assented to 22 February 2019] [Introduced 28 November 2018]

The Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory enacts as follows:

Part 1 Preliminary matters

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Justice Legislation Amendment Act 2019*.

This Act commences on the day after the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

91 Transitional matters for Justice Legislation Amendment Act 2019

If a person who held office as a Judge immediately before the commencement of section 12 of the *Justice Legislation Amendment Act 2019* resigns office on or after the day the person turns 70 years old and before the day the person turns 72 years old, for the purpose of determining the person's pension entitlement under section 4(2) or (3) of the *Supreme Court (Judges Pensions) Act 1985*, the particular age at which the person is to cease to hold office as a Judge is taken to be the exact age of the person on the day the resignation takes effect.
