NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 5 of 1995

AN ACT

to amend various Acts consequential on the passing
of the *Financial Management Act 1995*

[Assented to 21 March 1995]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

PART 1 - PRELIMINARY

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Financial Management (Consequential Amendments) Act 1995*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Financial Management Act 1995*.

PART 2 - AMENDMENTS TO NORTHERN TERRITORY UNIVERSITY ACT

3. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 31 of the *Northern Territory University Act* is repealed and the following substituted:

"31. ACCOUNTABLE OFFICER

"The Council shall appoint an Accountable Officer for the purposes of this Part."

4. BUDGET AND FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Section 40 of the *Northern Territory University Act* is amended by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following:

"(3) The Treasurer may at any time require the Accountable Officer appointed under section 31 to provide the Treasurer with such information as, in the Treasurer's opinion, is necessary to enable him or her to accurately assess the financial affairs of the University, including details of -

- (a) financial investments in corporations, trusts and joint ventures;
- (b) contingent liabilities; and
- (c) guarantees,

and the Accountable Officer shall provide that information accordingly."

5. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 41 of the *Northern Territory University Act* is repealed and the following substituted:

"41. ANNUAL REPORTS AND AUDIT

"(1) The Council shall, within the period of 6 months immediately following the end of the financial year or such other period as the Minister determines, prepare a report on the operations of the University during the financial year and forward it to the Minister.

"(2) The Accountable Officer appointed under section 31 shall, within the period of 3 months immediately following the end of the financial year or such other period as the Treasurer determines, prepare a financial statement in respect of the operations of the University or functions of the University specified in writing by the Treasurer.

"(3) A financial statement under subsection (2) shall be prepared in such form as the Treasurer directs.

"(4) The Accountable Officer shall forward the financial statements to the Auditor-General who shall audit it and, within the period of 3 months after receiving it or such other period as the Administrator allows, report on the statement to the Minister and forward a copy of the report to the Accountable Officer.

"(5) The Minister shall table the report under subsection (1), together with the financial statement and the report of the Auditor-General on the financial statement, in the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days of the Assembly after the delivery of the later of the reports to the Minister."

PART 3 - AMENDMENTS TO PUBLIC SECTOR EMPLOYMENT AND
MANAGEMENT ACT

6. PRINCIPAL ACT

The *Public Sector Employment and Management Act* is in this Part referred to as the Principal Act.

7. INTERPRETATION

Section 3(1) of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting the definition of "Agency" and substituting the following:

"'Agency' means a unit of government administration, or office or statutory corporation, nominated in an Administrative Arrangement Order as an Agency for the purposes of this Act;"; and

(b) by omitting from the definition of "Chief Executive Officer" paragraph (b) and substitute the following:

"(b) in the case of an Agency specified in Schedule 1, a person appointed under the Act by which the relevant office referred to in the second column of that Schedule was established, to act in that office,".

8. REPEAL

Section 5 of the Principal Act is repealed.

9. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 7 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following substituted:

"7. ESTABLISHMENT, CHANGE OF NAME AND ABOLITION OF AGENCIES

"(1) An Agency not otherwise established or continued in existence by or under an Act is established, by the name under which it is nominated, on the publication in the Gazette of the Administration Arrangements Order by which it is nominated as an Agency.

"(2) An Agency not established or continued in existence by or under an Act is abolished, or established by a different name nominated, on the publication in the Gazette of the Administrative Arrangements Order or amendment nominating the Agency by its new name or, in the case of the abolition of an Agency, the first Administrative Arrangements Order from which it is omitted or an amendment to the Administrative Order omitting its name, whichever is the earliest."

10. REPORTS BY CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

Section 28(3) of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting "an annual report to the appropriate minister" and substituting "an annual report, or present an audited financial statement under section 10 or 11 of the *Financial Management Act*, to the appropriate minister,"; and
- (b) by omitting "that other report" (three times occurring) and substituting "that other report or financial statement".

11. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Schedule 1 to the Principal Act is repealed and the following substituted:

12. PAYMENT OF BENEFITS

Section 29(2)(b) of the *Superannuation Act* is amended by omitting "Consolidated Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly" and substituting "public moneys of the Territory and the Allocation for that purpose is hereby established or increased to the extent necessary".

13. UNCLAIMED BENEFITS

Section 35 of the *Superannuation Act* is amended by omitting "Consolidated Fund" and substituting "Consolidated Revenue Account".

14. RECOVERY OF MONEY OWING TO FUND OR TERRITORY

Section 42(1) of the *Superannuation Act* is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) "the *Financial Administration and Audit Act* and the directions issued under section 35" and substituting "the *Financial Management Act* and the directions under section 38".

15. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 43 of the *Superannuation Act* is repealed and the following substituted:

"43. ANNUAL REPORTS AND AUDIT

"(1) Within the period of 6 months immediately following the end of the financial year or such other period as the Treasurer determines -

- (a) the Investment Board shall prepare and submit to the Minister -
 - (i) a report on its operations during the year; and
 - (ii) a financial statement in respect of the Fund prepared on commercial accounting principles or on such other basis as the Treasurer directs; and
- (b) the Commissioner shall prepare for submission to the Minister a report on the operation and management of the Scheme during the financial year.

"(2) The Investment Board shall, within 3 months immediately following the end of the financial year to which the statement relates, forward the financial statement referred to in subsection (1)(a)(i) to the Auditor-General who shall audit it and, within the period of 3 months after receiving it or such other period as the Administrator allows, report on the statement to the Minister and forward a copy of the report to the Investment Board.

"(3) The Minister shall table the reports under subsection (1), together with the financial statement and the report of the Auditor-General on the financial statement, in the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days of the Assembly after the delivery of the later of those reports to the Minister."

PART 5 - AMENDMENTS TO *TERRITORY INSURANCE OFFICE ACT*

16. DIRECTIONS OF MINISTER

Section 7(3) of the *Territory Insurance Office Act* is amended by omitting "section 68 of the *Financial Administration and Audit Act*" and substituting "section 10 of the *Financial Management Act*".

17. MONEYS ARE PROPERTY OF TERRITORY

Section 22A(2) of the *Territory Insurance Office Act* is amended by omitting "*Financial Administration and Audit Act*" and substituting "*Financial Management Act*".

18. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Sections 26 and 27 of the *Territory Insurance Office Act* is repealed and the following substituted:

"26. PAYMENT OF SURPLUS MONEYS TO TERRITORY

"(1) The Minister may direct that any amount of funds held by the Office which, in the Minister's opinion, is in excess of that required as adequate provision for actual and contingent liabilities or for the reasonable operating and other expenses of the Office shall -

- (a) in the case of moneys standing to the credit of an account established for the purposes of a motor accident compensation scheme administered by the Office - be paid into a fund maintained within the appropriate Agency Operating Account under the *Financial Management Act*; and
- (b) in any other case - be paid into the Consolidated Revenue Account.

"(2) An amount paid by the Office under subsection (1)(a) shall only be used to promote or participate in the promotion of road safety.

"27. AUDIT AND ANNUAL REPORT

"(1) The Board shall, within the period of 6 months immediately following the end of the financial year or such other period as the Minister determines, prepare a report on the operations of the Office during the financial year and forward it to the Minister.

"(2) The Minister shall table the report under subsection (1), together with the financial statement and report of the Auditor-General on the financial statement required pursuant to subsection (3), in the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days of the Assembly after the delivery of the later of the reports to the Minister.

"(3) Subject to subsection (2), section 10 of the *Financial Management Act* applies to and in relation to the Office as if its activities were a Government Business Division within the meaning of that Act.

"(4) For the purposes of the application of section 10 of the *Financial Management Act* as referred to in subsection (3), the Chief Executive Officer is the Accountable Officer."
