



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

to amend the *Firearms Act 1992*

[Assented to 18 March 1993]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Firearms Act 1992 Amendment Act 1993*.

2. REQUIREMENT FOR PHOTOGRAPH

Section 13 of the *Firearms Act 1992* is amended by omitting subsection (5) and substituting the following:

"(5) An applicant shall not provide a photograph in purported compliance with a requirement under subsection (1)(a) which is not a photograph of the applicant.

Penalty: \$2,000 or imprisonment for 6 months."

3. SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRATION, LICENCES, &c.

Section 37(1)(d) of the *Firearms Act 1992* is amended by omitting "section 80" and substituting "section 81".

4. DISPOSAL OF FIREARMS

Section 39(3) of the *Firearms Act 1992* is amended by omitting "section 81(1)" and substituting "section 82(1)".

5. SEARCHES AND EMERGENCIES

Section 77(1)(b) of the *Firearms Act 1992* is amended by omitting "an offence against this Act" and substituting "a disqualifying offence".

6. REPORT TO BE MADE IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES

Section 81 of the *Firearms Act 1992* is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(3) In this section, a reference to a medical practitioner includes a reference to a practitioner who is registered to practise in the category of psychology within the meaning of the *Health Practitioners and Allied Professionals Registration Act*.".
