

## NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 60 of 1992

## AN ACT

to amend the Control of Roads Act

[Assented to 22 October 1992]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Control of Roads Amendment Act 1992.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Local Government Amendment Act (No. 3) 1992.

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The *Control of Roads Act* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. INTERPRETATION

Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by inserting, after the definition of "attached", the following:
- "'community government council' means a community government council within the meaning of the Local Government Act;";
- (b) by omitting the definition of "pedestrian mall"; and

(c) by inserting at the end the following:

"(2) In Parts III and IV, 'road' does not include a road which, under section 91 of the *Local Government Act*, is under the care, control and management of a council or a community government council.".

## 5. ROADS, &c., VESTED IN TERRITORY

Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Planning Act" and substituting "Planning Act and section 91 of the Local Government Act".

6. REPEAL

Sections 25A and 25B of the Principal Act are repealed.
