

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

to amend the Oaths Act

[Assented to 26 September 1991]

B E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth. as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Oaths Amendment Act 1991.

2. COMMENCEMENT

1

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Justices of the Peace Act 1991.

3. AMENDMENT OF OATHS ACT

(1) The Oaths Act is amended -

(a) by adding at the end of section 5 the following:

"(2) The affirmation of allegiance shall be in accordance with the form in Schedule 2A.";

(b) by adding at the end of section 9 the following:

"(2) A person making an affirmation before a Court shall be addressed by an officer in accordance with the form in Schedule 7 and shall thereupon speak the words 'I do' or otherwise signify his or her assent."; and

(c) by inserting after Schedule 2 the following:

"SCHEDULE 2A

AFFIRMATION OF ALLEGIANCE

I, do solemnly, sincerely and truly affirm that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to our Sovereign Lady the Queen according to law.".

(2) The Oaths Act is further amended as provided for in the Schedule.
