

## NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

# AN ACT

to amend the *Registration Act* to consolidate and regulate fees payable to the Registrar-General

[Assented to 26 September 1991]

**B**E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

#### 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Registration Amendment Act 1991.

#### 2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

#### 3. NEW SECTION

The Registration Act is amended by adding at the end the following:

#### "11. REGULATIONS

- "(1) The Administrator may make regulations, not inconsistent with this Act, prescribing matters -
  - (a) required or permitted by this Act to be prescribed; or
  - (b) necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or giving effect to this Act.

### Registration Amendment

- "(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the regulations may prescribe -
  - (a) a matter or thing, or a service provided by the Registrar-General, for which a fee is, under this or any other Act, required to be paid to the Registrar-General; and
  - (b) the amount of the fees referred to in paragraph (a).".
