NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 33 of 1990

AN ACT

to revise and correct the law of the Territory in minor respects

[Assented to 11 June 1990]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Statute Law Revision Act 1990.

2. AMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE ACT

The Administration and Probate Act is amended by omitting Division 7 of Part III and substituting the following:

"Division 7 - Commission

"102. EXECUTORS, &c., MAY BE ALLOWED COMMISSION

- "(1) It shall be lawful for the Court to allow out of the assets of a deceased person to his executor, administrator or trustee for the time being, in passing his accounts, such commission or percentage, not exceeding 5% for his pains and trouble as is just and reasonable.
- "(2) No such allowance shall be made to an executor, administrator or trustee who neglects or omits, without a special order of the Court, to pass his accounts in accordance with section 89.".

3. AMENDMENT TO CROWN LANDS ACT

Section 102M of the Crown Lands Act is amended -

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) all the words after and including "section 46(1A)" and substituting the following:

"section 46(1A) of the Lands Acquisition Act -

- (d) form an association of Aboriginals incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act or the Aboriginal Councils and Associations Act 1976 of the Commonwealth; or
- (e) approve an association already formed under either of the Acts specified in paragraph (d), being an association which, at the time of the approval, does not hold and is not intended to hold, other land as an Aboriginal community living area under Part IV of this Act,

to hold the land."; and

(b) by omitting from subsection (2) "upon the formation of an association referred to in subsection (1)" and substituting "upon being advised of the formation of an association referred to in subsection (1)(d) or of the approval of an association referred to in subsection (1)(e)".

4. AMENDMENTS TO INTERPRETATION ACT

Section 18 of the Interpretation Act is amended -

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "Auditor-General" the following:
- "'Commissioner of Police' means the Commissioner of Police appointed or holding office under the Police Administration Act;"; and
- (b) by inserting after the definition of "medical practitioner" the following:
- "'member of the Police Force' means a member of the Police Force appointed or holding office under the Police Administration Act;".

5. AMENDMENT TO LANDS ACQUISITION ACT

Section 46(1A) of the Lands Acquisition Act is amended by inserting, after "formed", the words "or approved".

6. AMENDMENT TO MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT

Section 37(1) of the *Misuse of Drugs Act 1990* is amended by omitting the definition of "aggravating circumstances" and substituting the following:

- "'aggravating circumstance' means, subject to subsection (2) -
- (a) a second or subsequent offence against -
 - (i) this Act; or
 - (ii) a provision of -
 - (A) a law in force in the Territory before the commencement of this Act; or
 - (B) a law of the Commonwealth or a State or another Territory of the Commonwealth (whether the offence was committed before or after the commencement of this Act),

which, in the opinion of the court, is the equivalent of or a similar offence to an offence against a provision of this Act;

- (b) an offence against this Act in circumstances involving a prison or police prison or a prisoner (within the meaning of the Prisons (Correctional Services) Act); or
- (c) an offence against section 5 or 9 committed on or in licensed premises, a school, playground, youth centre, video facility or public swimming pool;".
- 7. AMENDMENTS TO OMBUDSMAN (NORTHERN TERRITORY) ACT

Section 9 of the *Ombudsman (Northern Territory) Act* is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following:

- "(1) Subject to subsection (1AA), the Administrator may appoint a person to act in the office of the Ombudsman during -
 - (a) a period, or during all periods, when the person holding the office is absent from duty or from the Territory or is, for any other reason unable to perform the duties of his office;
 - (b) the suspension from office of the person holding the office; or
 - (c) a vacancy in the office.

"(1AA) A person appointed under subsection (1) shall not act in the office of the Ombudsman for a continuous period exceeding 3 months unless the appointment was made on the recommendation of the Legislative Assembly.".

8. AMENDMENT TO REAL PROPERTY AMENDMENT ACT (NO. 2) 1989

- (1) The Schedule to the Real Property Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989 is amended by inserting in the second column, opposite to the second last item in the first column, the words "the whole sections".
- (2) Subsection (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 February 1990 immediately before the commencement of the Real Property Amendment Act (No. 2) 1989.

9. STATUTE LAW REVISION

The provisions of the Acts and Regulations specified in the Schedule are amended as provided for in the Schedule.
