



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

to amend the *Abattoirs and Slaughtering Act*

[Assented to 12 April 1990]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Abattoirs and Slaughtering Amendment Act 1990*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Stock Diseases Amendment Act 1990*.

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The *Abattoirs and Slaughtering Act* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. INTERPRETATION

Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting the definition of "Chief Inspector" and substituting the following:

"'Chief Inspector' means the Chief Inspector of Stock appointed under the *Stock Diseases Act*"; and

- (b) by inserting at the end of the definition of "Inspector" the words "and an inspector appointed under the *Stock Diseases Act* except where the Minister has otherwise directed under section 11 of that Act".

5. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 6 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following substituted:

"6. INSPECTORS

"The Minister may appoint such persons as the Minister thinks fit to be Inspectors of Abattoirs.

"6A. IDENTITY CARDS

"(1) The Chief Inspector shall issue to each Inspector appointed under section 6 an identity card containing a photograph and the signature of the Inspector verified by the signature of the Chief Inspector.

"(2) An Inspector issued with an identity card under subsection (1) shall, on the termination of the Inspector's appointment, surrender the identity card to the Chief Inspector."
