

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 3 of 1990

AN ACT

to amend the Brands Act

[Assented to 2 April 1990]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Brands Amendment Act (No. 2) 1990.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Stock Diseases Amendment Act 1990.

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Brands Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act .

4. DEFINITIONS

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of the definition of "inspector" the words ", and includes the Registrar, a member of the Police Force, and an inspector appointed under the Stock Diseases Act except where the Minister has otherwise directed under section 11 of that Act".

5. REGISTRAR OF BRANDS

Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting "Until the Minister otherwise directs, the" and substituting "The"; and
- (b) by omitting "Stock Diseases Ordinance 1927" and substituting "Stock Diseases Act".

6. APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS

Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a).

7. NEW SECTION

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 9 the following:

"9A. IDENTITY CARDS

- "(1) The Registrar shall issue to each inspector appointed under section 9(c) an identity card containing a photograph and the signature of the inspector verified by the signature of the Registrar.
- "(2) An inspector issued with an identity card under subsection (1) shall, on the termination of the inspector's appointment, surrender the identity card to the Registrar.".

8. REPEAL OF SECTION 10

Section 10 of the Principal Act is repealed.
