AN ACT

to amend the Crimes (Forfeiture of Proceeds) Act

[Assented to 12 April 1990]

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory* (*Self-Government*) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Crimes (Forfeiture of Proceeds) Amendment Act 1990.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1990.

3. INTERPRETATION

Section 3(1) of the Crimes (Forfeiture of Proceeds)
Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting the definition of "narcotic substance" and substituting the following:
- "'narcotic substance' means a dangerous drug within the meaning of the Misuse of Drugs Act;"; and
- (b) by omitting the definition of "serious offence" and substituting the following:

"'serious offence' means an offence -

- (a) against a law of the Territory, being an offence that may be prosecuted on indictment; or
- (b) prescribed for the purposes of this paragraph or an offence of a kind so prescribed;".
