

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 38 of 1989

AN ACT

to amend the Parole Orders (Transfer) Act

[Assented to 20 September 1989]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Parole Orders (Transfer) Amendment Act 1989.

2. DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPANY REQUESTS

Section 6(1) of the Parole Orders (Transfer) Act is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting the following:

"(b) the judgment, order, direction, declaration or other authority which authorized the imprisonment of the person to whom the parole order relates;".

REGISTRATION

Section 8 of the Parole Orders (Transfer) Act is amended -

(a) by omitting subsection (1)(b) and substituting the following:

Parole Orders (Transfer) Amendment

- "(b) keeping the endorsed parole order in a register together with the original or copy of the judgment, order, direction, declaration or other authority, by virtue of which the person to whom the parole order relates became liable to undergo the relevant imprisonment, sent by the designated authority."; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2)(a) "judgment or order" and substituting "judgment, order, direction, declaration or other authority".

4. NEW SECTION

The Parole Orders (Transfer) Act is amended by inserting after section 10 the following:

"10A. EXCLUSION OF RULES OF NATURAL JUSTICE

"The rules known as the rules of natural justice (including any duty of procedural fairness) do not apply to or in relation to a direction, request or decision given or made by the Minister under this Act.".
