



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 40 of 1986

AN ACT

to amend the *Liquor Act*

[Assented to 19 September 1986]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Liquor Amendment Act (No. 2) 1986*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

(1) Sections 1 and 2 shall come into operation on the day on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

(2) The remaining provisions of this Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the *Racing, Gaming and Liquor Commission Act 1986* (other than sections 1 and 2 of that Act).

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The *Liquor Act* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. DEFINITIONS

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting the definition of "Chairman" and substituting the following:

"'Chairman' means the Chairman of the Commission;"

- (b) by omitting the definition of "Commission" and substituting the following:

"'Commission' means the Racing, Gaming and Liquor Commission as constituted under section 5(3) of the *Racing, Gaming and Liquor Commission Act*";

- (c) by omitting the definitions of "Deputy Chairman" and "legal practitioner"; and
- (d) by omitting from the definition of "member" the words "and Deputy Chairman".

5. REPEAL

Division 1 of Part II of the Principal Act is repealed.

6. ASSESSORS NOT TO ACT WHERE INTERESTED

Section 20 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) -
 - (i) "or a member"; and
 - (ii) "or member";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) "or a member";
- (c) by omitting from subsection (3) -
 - (i) "or a member";
 - (ii) "or member, as the case may be,"; and
 - (iii) all words after "as the case may be" (second occurring);
- (d) by omitting from subsection (4) -
 - (i) "or a member";
 - (ii) "or member, as the case may be,"; and
 - (iii) "or member's"; and
- (e) by omitting subsection (5).

7. REPEAL

Section 21 of the Principal Act is repealed.

8. PROTECTION OF ASSESSORS, &c.

Section 23 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "the Commission, a member," (twice occurring).
