

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

to amend the Liquor Act

[Assented to 14 July 1986]

B it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Liquor Amendment Act* 1986.

2. COMMENCEMENT

(1) Sections 1 and 2 shall come into operation on the date on which the Administrator's assent to this Act is declared.

(2) Section 3 shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. NEW SECTION

The *Liquor Act* is amended by inserting after section 116 the following:

"116A. MINORS NOT TO SELL, &c., LIQUOR

"(1) Except in accordance with a condition of his licence or as permitted under subsection (2) by the Commission, a licensee shall not employ a person under the age of 18 years to sell, supply or serve liquor on licensed premises.

"(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the Commission may in writing, either generally or, on the application of a licensee, in relation to a particular person, permit a licensee to employ a person under the age of 18 years to sell, supply or serve liquor on licensed premises where the Commission is satisfied that the person is a genuine employee of the licensee or is undergoing employment training at the licensed premises.".
