

## NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 39 of 1983

# AN ACT

To amend the Financial Administration and Audit Act

[Assented to 3 October 1983]

**B**E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

#### 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Financial Administration and Audit Amendment Act 1983.

#### 2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Financial Administration and Audit Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

#### DEFINITIONS

Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "audit" the following:

"'Auditor-General' means the person appointed under section 38 as the Auditor-General, and includes a person appointed under section 38(6) to act as Auditor-General;".

#### 4. APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR-GENERAL

Section 38 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (2) "of the Northern Territory";
- (b) by inserting after "Administrator" in subsection (5) "or, in the case of a person appointed under sub-section (6) by the Minister to act as the Auditor-General, may resign his office by writing signed by him and delivered to the Minister";

#### Financial Administration and Audit Amendment

- (c) by inserting after "the Administrator" in sub-section (6) "or, subject to sub-section (6A), the Minister";
- (d) by inserting after sub-section (6) the following:
- "(6A) An appointment made under sub-section (6) by the Minister shall be for a period not exceeding 3 months but a person so appointed may be re-appointed to act as Auditor-General for further periods each not exceeding 3 months."; and
  - (e) by adding at the end the following:
- "(8) The validity of anything done by a person acting as Auditor-General in pursuance of an appointment under sub-section (6) shall not be called in question by reason of a defect or irregularity in or in relation to his appointment or on the ground that the occasion for his acting had not arisen or had ceased.".

#### 5. REPEAL AND SUBSTITUTION

Section 40 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following substituted:

## "40. LEAVE OF ABSENCE OF AUDITOR-GENERAL

"Subject to section 38(3), the Minister may grant leave of absence to the Auditor-General.".

## 6. MISBEHAVIOUR OF AUDITOR-GENERAL

Section 44(c) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "the Administrator" and substituting "the Minister or under section 38(3)".
