



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 91 of 1982

AN ACT

To amend the *Legal Practitioners Act*

[Assented to 14 December 1982]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners Amendment Act (No. 2) 1982*.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. DEFINITIONS

Section 6 of the *Legal Practitioners Act* is amended by omitting "IX, X and XI" and substituting "IX and X".

4. CERTAIN PRACTITIONERS TO HOLD PRACTISING CERTIFICATES

Section 22 of the *Legal Practitioners Act* is amended by inserting after sub-section (3) the following:

"(3A) A legal practitioner, other than the Solicitor-General or the Crown Solicitor within the meaning of the *Law Officers Act*, who is an employee, within the meaning of the *Public Service Act*, in the Department of Law, shall not practise in the Territory as a legal practitioner unless he holds, or is, in pursuance of section 30, to be deemed to hold, a current restricted practising certificate."
