

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 60 of 1982

AN ACT

To amend the Coroners Act [Assented to 8 October 1982]

B it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Coroners Amendment Act 1982.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Bail Act 1982.

3. CORONER'S FINDINGS AND SUBSEQUENT PROCEDURE

Section 37 of the Coroners Act is amended -

(a) by omitting sub-section (7) and substituting the following:

"(7) The Bail Act and Part V of the Justices Act apply to and in relation to a person in respect of whom the Coroner has formed an opinion that the person should be put upon his trial for an indictable offence as if that person were committed for trial under the Justices Act.";

and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (8) "under the Justices Act." and substituting "under the Bail Act and the Justices Act.".
