# AN ACT

To amend the Claims by and against the Government Act
[Assented to 8 October 1982]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

#### 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Claims by and against the Government Amendment Act 1982.

#### COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Bail Act 1982.

3. RECOVERY OF MONEY FORFEITED UNDER BAIL ACT, &c.

Section 4 of the *Claims by and against the Government*Act is amended by omitting sub-section (1) and substituting the following:

- "(1) Where -
- (a) a Court makes an order under section 40(1) of the Bail Act that an amount of money be forfeited and paid to the Territory; or
- (b) a person has entered into a recognizance and a Court declares that the recognizance is forfeited or estreated,

notwithstanding any other order made by the Court, a certificate under the hand of -

(c) the judge, magistrate, justice or justices who made the order; or

### Claims by and against the Government Amendment

(d) the judge or magistrate who ordered the forfeiture of, or estreated, the recognizance, as the case may be, may be filed in a court of competent jurisdiction.".
