

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 84 of 1982

AN ACT

To amend the Annual Leave Act

[Assented to 14 December 1982]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Annual Leave Amendment Act 1982.

2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The ${\it Annual Leave Act}$ is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. INTERPRETATION

Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of "employee" the words ", and includes a casual employee".

4. ANNUAL LEAVE TAKEN BEFORE DUE

Section 8(3) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after "employment" (first occurring) the word "not".

LEAVE RECORDS

Section 16(2)(a) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "2 years" and substituting "3 years".

Annual Leave Amendment

6. NEW SECTION

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 19 the following:

"19A. TIME FOR COMMENCING PROCEEDING

"Notwithstanding anything in another law, proceedings for an offence against this Act may be instituted within the period of 3 years after the act or omission alleged to constitute the offence.".
