# AN ACT

## To amend the Food and Drugs Act

[Assented to 23 February 1982]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

## 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the  $\underline{Food\ and\ Drugs\ Amendment\ Act}$  (No. 2) 1981.

### 2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Food and Drugs Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

#### 3. POWERS OF INSPECTION AND SAMPLING

Section 21(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting the following:

- "(a) enter and inspect any place, other than a private dwellinghouse where food is not prepared for sale, at, in or upon which he has reasonable ground for believing there may be an article -
  - (i) which is, or is likely to be used -
    - (A) as food; or
    - (B) in the making, manufacture, sale, storage delivery, conveyance or preparation of food; or
  - (ii) the sale of which is prohibited under this Act, and may inspect any such article;".

## Food and Drugs Amendment (No. 2)

#### 4. DEALING IN ABSINTHE PROHIBITED

Section 109(1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "40 dollars" and "100 dollars" and substituting "\$500" and "\$1,000" respectively.

## 5. PENALTIES

Section 110 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "40 dollars", "10 dollars" and "200 dollars" and substituting "\$500", "\$100" and "\$2,500" respectively.

## 6. REGULATIONS

Section 111(b) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "40 dollars", "10 dollars" and "200 dollars" and substituting "\$500", "\$100" and "\$2,500" respectively.
