



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

AN ACT

To amend the Food and Drugs Act

[Assented to 21 December 1981]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Food and Drugs Amendment Act 1981.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on the commencement of the Public Health Amendment Act 1981.

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Food and Drugs Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. DEFINITION

Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of "Inspector" the words "Inspector of Health" and substituting "Health Surveyor".

5. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The Principal Act is further amended as set out in the Schedule.
