# AN ACT

#### To amend the Public Health Act

[Assented to 21 December 1981]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Public Health Amendment Act 1981.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the <u>Gazette</u>.

### 3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The <u>Public Health Act</u> is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. DEFINITIONS

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by inserting after the definition of "Health Officer" the following:
- "'Health Surveyor' means a Health Surveyor appointed under section 6(2);"; and
- (b) by omitting the definition of "Inspector".

#### 5. APPOINTMENTS

Section 6(2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Inspectors of Health" and substituting "Health Surveyors".

6. POWERS OF CHIEF MEDICAL OFFICER AND MEDICAL OFFICER OF HEALTH

Section 7(2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "an Inspector" and substituting "a Health Surveyor".

## 7. HEALTH OFFICERS

Section 7B(2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "an Inspector of Health" and substituting "a Health Surveyor".

## 8. FURTHER AMENDMENTS

The Principal Act is further amended as set out in the Schedule.
