



NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 73 of 1981

AN ACT

To amend the Stock Diseases Act

[Assented to 18 September 1981]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Stock Diseases Amendment Act (No. 3) 1981.

2. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Stock Diseases Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

3. DECLARATION OF RESTRICTED AREAS, &c.

Section 22A(1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after "vessel," (twice occurring), the word "holding,".

4. CHIEF INSPECTOR MAY GIVE DIRECTION OR ORDER IN RELATION TO RESTRICTED AREA

Section 22B of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1)(a) the word "and" (last occurring);

(b) by adding after sub-section (1)(b) the following:

"; and

(c) may give an order in writing directing the removal or disposal, from a holding declared under this Division to be a restricted area, of an animal or thing specified in the order."; and

(c) by inserting in sub-section (2)(a) after "vessel," the word "holding,".

Stock Diseases Amendment (No. 3)

5. NOTICE REQUIRING STOCK TO BE DIPPED, &c.

Section 41 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following:

"(c) require that stock of a specified species or class shall be treated and marked in a specified manner; and".

6. POWERS OF AN INSPECTOR

Section 42(1) of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting from paragraph (u) "and" (last occurring); and

(b) by adding after paragraph (v) the following:

"; and

(w) order the owner or person in charge of stock of a specified species or class to apply such identifying marks and devices as are specified by the Chief Inspector under section 41(c).".
