## AN ACT

To amend the Law Officers Act

[Assented to 25 March 1981]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Law Officers Amendment Act 1981.

2. OFFICES OF SOLICITOR-GENERAL AND CROWN SOLICITOR

Section 8 of the <u>Law Officers Act</u> is amended by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following:

"(3) The Attorney-General may appoint a person, who is qualified for appointment under sub-section (1), to act from time to time as the Solicitor-General or Crown Solicitor, as the case may be, during the absence from duty of the Solicitor-General or Crown Solicitor or a vacancy in either of those offices.".
