

NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 57 of 1985

AN ACT

To amend the Supreme Court Act

[Assented to 9 December 1985]

B^E it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Supreme Court Amendment Act 1985.

2. COMMENCEMENT

This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.

3. PRINCIPAL ACT

The Supreme Court Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

4. NEW SECTION

The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 50 in Part III the following:

"50A. APPLICATION

"This Part does not apply to an appeal under Division 2 of Part X of the *Criminal Code*.".

5. FORM OF JUDGMENT ON APPEAL

Section 55 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (2)(d), (5) and (8).

6. RULES OF COURT

Section 86 of the Principal Act is amended -

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2)(a) "court" and substituting "Court"; and
- (b) by adding at the end the following -

"(4) In this section "Court" includes the Court of Criminal Appeal established by section 407 of the *Criminal Code*.".
