To amend the Special Purposes
Leases Ordinance

BE it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

| 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Special Purposes Leases Ordinance</u> (No. 2) 1978. | Short title |
| 2. The <u>Special Purposes Leases Ordinance</u> is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. | Principal Ordinance |
| 3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date on which the <u>Aboriginal Land Ordinance</u> 1978 comes into operation. | Commencement |
| 4. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended - | Definitions |
| (a) by inserting before the definition of "aboriginal reserve" the following definition: | |
| " 'Aboriginal Land Council' means the Aboriginal Land Council established under section 21 of the <u>Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act</u> 1976 for the area that contains the particular area of land,"; and | |
| (b) by omitting the definition of "the Board". | |
| 5. Sections 4A, 4B, 4C and 4D of the Principal Ordinance are repealed. | Repeal of certain provisions |
| 6. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "the Board" (wherever occurring) and substituting "the Aboriginal Land Council". | Lessee may transfer, &c., his lease |
