

THE NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA

No. 132 of 1978

AN ACT

To amend the Traffic Act

[Assented to 21 December 1978]

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Northern Territory of Australia, with the assent as provided by the *Northern Territory (Self-Government) Act 1978* of the Commonwealth, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Traffic Act (No. 3) 1978. Short title
2. The Traffic Act is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act
3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended - Interpretation
 - (a) by omitting from the definition of "bicycle" the words "includes tricycle and any contrivance of a similar nature" and substituting "includes a tricycle, any contrivance of a similar nature or a powered cycle";
 - (b) by inserting after the definition of "medical practitioner" the following definition:

"'motor cycle' does not include a powered cycle";
 - (c) by omitting from the definition of "motor vehicle" the words "but does not include any vehicle used on a railway" and substituting "but does not include any vehicle used on a railway or a powered cycle"; and

Traffic (No. 3)

(d) by inserting after the definition of "pole type trailer" the following definition:

"'powered cycle' means a bicycle, tricycle or any contrivance of a similar nature which is equipped -

(a) with pedals which may be used as a means of propulsion; and

(b) with an engine, motor or other device which is capable of producing a power output not exceeding 200 watts;"
